AN ORDER APPROVING A REQUEST BY HARRIS COUNTY FRESH WATER SUPPLY  
DISTRICT NO. 52 TO CHANGE ITS NAME  
TO CHAMPIONS MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT

An application by Harris County Fresh Water Supply District No. 52 (District) was presented to the Executive Director of the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) for consideration of approval pursuant to TEX. WATER CODE §§5.122 and 49.071, and 30 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §293.102. The District requests approval to change the District's name from Harris County Fresh Water Supply District No. 52 to Champions Municipal Utility District.

The TCEQ has jurisdiction to consider this matter after examining the application and supporting documentation and finds that the District's request to change its name from Harris County Fresh Water Supply District No. 52 to Champions Municipal Utility District should be approved. The District should be directed to follow the requirements of TEX. WATER CODE §49.071(c) regarding publishing and mailing the notice of the name change. The District should be directed to install new name signs as prescribed in TEX. WATER CODE §49.451.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED BY THE TEXAS COMMISSION ON ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY that the District's request to change its name from Harris County Fresh Water Supply District No. 52 to Champions Municipal Utility District is approved. The District is directed to follow the requirements of TEX. WATER CODE §49.071(c) regarding publishing and mailing the notice of the name change.
